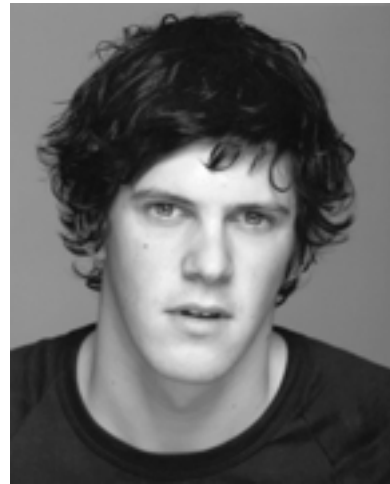


SAM NORTH

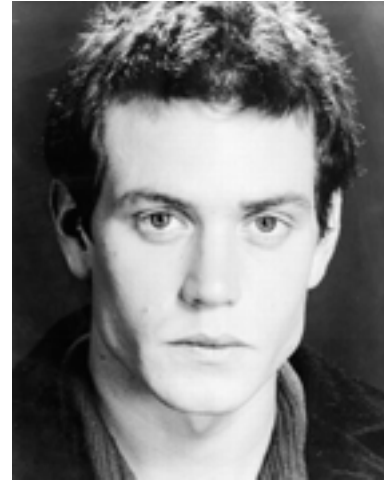
